An Introduction to Digital Audio Broadcasting (DAB) Unlike AM and FM frequencies (also called "analogue" radio frequencies) where one radio station is broadcast on one analogue frequency (such as 94.9 MHz used by BBC Radio London), DAB frequencies (such as 223.936 MHz used by the Greater London II multiplex) can carry multiple radio services on the same frequency.
