Medical marijuana "prescriptions" are more often called "recommendations" or "referrals" because of the federal prescription prohibition. States with medical marijuana laws generally have some form of patient registry, which may provide some protection against arrest for possession up to a certain amount of marijuana for personal medicinal use.

Proposition 215, passed in 1996, was the nation's first medical marijuana law (California Bureau of Medical Cannabis). Eligible patients must present a "written or oral recommendation" from their physician. Guidelines passed in 2003 set

While all forms of marijuana are still illegal based on federal laws, a few courageous states have started implementing medical marijuana laws, but most are complex and hard to understand.

Medical marijuana is illegal in Kentucky; however, the state has passed a medical bill in 2014 that permits the use of low-THC cannabis. Kentucky's low-THC medical cannabis law authorizes low-THC oil to be excluded from the definition of marijuana, thereby legal for patients with intractable epilepsy who have a written recommendation from a
