The physical response to unease is to pull in and up in a kind of knot propped up on legs. This excess tension in the respiratory diaphragm and pelvic floor are going to restrict oxygen intake and carbon dioxide output, creating a kind of "starvation" response in the muscles and a feeling of fatigue throughout the body.

The area under the brooder must be kept clear for brooding the chicks. The day-old chick's

temperature is about 3 °F below that of an adult's. Its body temperature starts rising about 4 days of age and reaches its maximum at 10 days. The chick needs time to develop temperature control (2 to 4 weeks).

3 Methods for Brooding Chicks, with Temperature ...

Just like an adult's, the baby's heart rate normally beats faster during activity, especially later in pregnancy. The test will monitor heart rate variability in response to fetal movement. Otherwise, the baby could be experiencing fetal hypoxia—a condition where he or she does not get adequate oxygen.

If young chickens are vaccinated when maternal antibody levels are still high, the vaccine may be neutralised excessively by the maternal antibodies, which will result in a reduced immune response. Conversely, if vaccinations are delayed and maternal antibody levels drop too low, a severe vaccine reaction may result and the chick will be left vulnerable to disease prior to vaccination.
